- 1. The Nicolet Walk/Run Operations Team will be monitoring the National Weather Service forecasts and radar throughout the morning.
- 2.If there is a threat and/or we are experiencing thunder, lightening or storms at 8:45, the race will be postponed until the severe weather has passed.
- 3.Should the threat remain at 9:45, the Walk/Run will be cancelled. Unfortunately, there will be no refunds due to weather situations.
- 4.Our Race Operations Team will make the decision on the side of caution. The SAFETY of the Walkers, Runners, Spectators and Volunteers is far more important than the risk of having 200+ stuck outdoors in a dangerous weather situation.
